

This is a guideline for when end of unit White Rose Maths Assessments should be completed. Please note there may need to be adjustments to this schedule due to when units have been completed – please discuss any adjustments with Nik.

Key notes:

- Maths Assessments for each year group are saved here: <https://www.chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk/page/?title=In+School+Maths+White+Rose+Blocks+Assessments&pid=1363> with each year group having its own page.
- Unit assessments are organised in the order they appear on the White Rose Scheme of Learning and separated by term.
- Unit assessments should be complete within 2 weeks of a unit being covered.
- When you are scheduling an assessment, please email the Maths Leader and ask them to add the specific assessment to your year group's iPads – this will make it much easier for your classes to access the assessment.
- Children should have their Maths Assessment book available to them when completing assessments to help them record any working out.
- Maths planners – at the time of scheduling – please look at the forthcoming assessment and raise any queries or concerns with the Maths Leader so that any necessary adjustments can be made.
- Maths planners will be e-mailed a link to access data from completed assessments to help inform future planning.
- Upon completion – please notify the Maths Leader who will then download the data and save pupil results along with guideline grades in a folder within your current year group planning, e.g. Y:\Teaching & Learning\Subjects\Mathematics\maths planning\Year 3\2022-23\End of Unit Assessments
- Key columns to look at initially are E, F and G which contain scores – year teams can then explore further for breakdown of individual question performance. Maths planners should use this to help prioritise coverage within extra 30 minutes Maths time and Turbo Maths.
