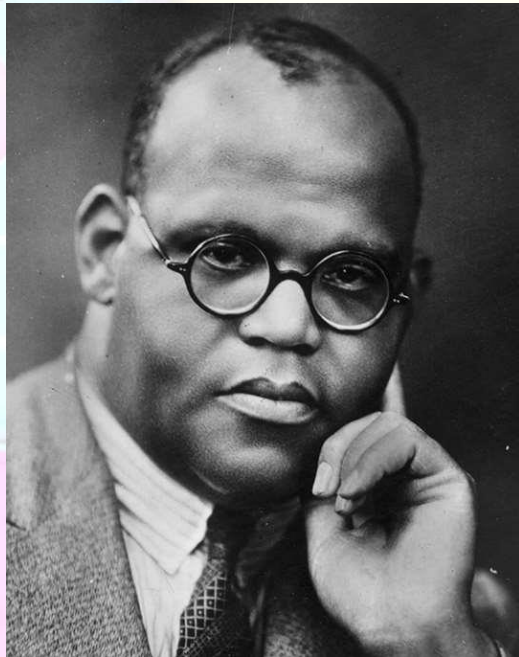

First female UK artist to debut number 1 in Billboards blues chart (America, 2007)
