




Y3 PE Knowledge Organiser— Scooter Skills & Road Safety



Key Knowledge

Key Vocabulary

Understand these key words

Word	Definition
Awareness	Knowing what is around you at all times
Balance	Making sure you stay upright on your scooter at all times
Brake	Using your foot on the brake on the back wheel and not the floor
Control	Being able to stop, start, steer and avoid obstacles.
Crossings	Places to cross the road or railway line safely
Hazard	A danger (such as a car/lorry) in the road or an obstacle to avoid.
Helmet	Protective equipment for your head—must be worn at all times.
Scooter	Mode of transport (2 or 3 wheels)
Steering	Using control to direct the scooter in the desired location.
Stopping	Bringing the scooter to a stop in a safe distance. From any hazard.
Vehicle	Cars / lorries / motorbikes / bicycles - other road users

THE GREEN CROSS CODE

A thorough knowledge of the Green Cross Code is vitally important to primary school children **over 7 years**:

1. First find a safe place to cross
2. Stop just before you get to the kerb
3. Look all around for traffic and listen
4. If traffic is coming, let it pass, look all around again and listen
5. When it is safe go straight across the road - do not run
6. Keep looking and listening for traffic while you cross
