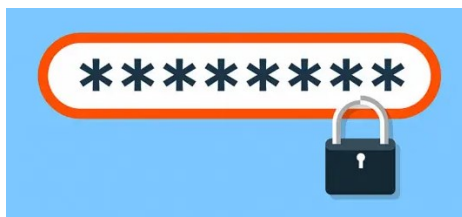

Avatar

Password



Passwords need to be kept secret so only you can log in to your accounts. If you think someone has access to your password you should tell an adult who can help you to change your password.

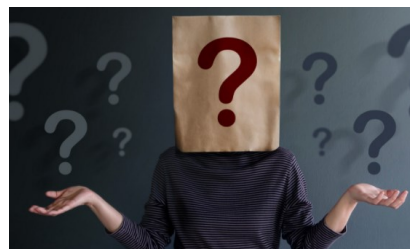
Online responsibility
