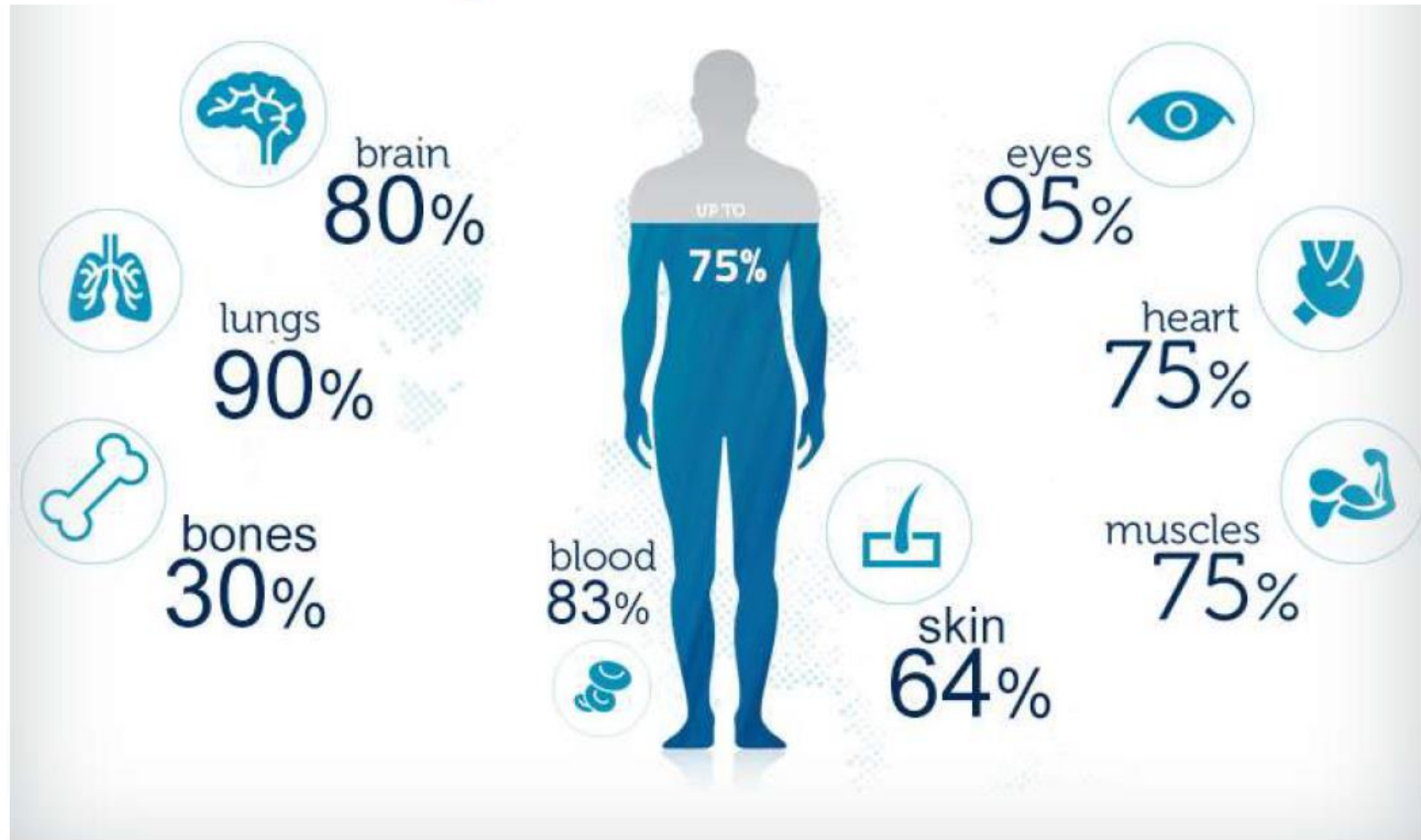

FUNDRAISING – SENSORY ROOM AND SUPPORT FOR DISADVANTAGE CHILDREN

My name is Mariana, my eldest child is about to finish year 3 at Chesswood Junior School. It has been an eventful year, but we have had incredible support from the Pastoral Team at Chesswood. This has allowed my little man to flourish despite the challenges that came with the transition to a new school. We have a bunch of very passionate, dedicated people trying to do the best for the kids at the school.

Sounds incredible, right?

Drum roll.....enter budget cuts.

There are major obstacles currently to providing the support children need in most schools, but in this case, I am fundraising for the following Chesswood Junior School projects

1. Development of a sensory room, £6000.

This will be amazing for neurodivergent children and any children struggling with the classroom environment, of which there are many. This funding will allow for a purpose-built space with the right resources and equipment. All these kids need is to feel safe and that they belong, and the correct sensory input at that point of dysregulation is of paramount importance to allow this. Let's make it happen.

2. Funds for disadvantaged children to engage in positive experiences in the community, £2000

Most of you are hopefully able to provide enriching experiences for your children, be it Christmas activities, visits to parks and activity centres or other fun things we all take for granted! If you are in the same advantaged position as my family is, you will not be able to easily imagine a reality where your children cannot engage in these socially enriching activities, right? Our community has many children in this situation. Chesswood has been inspiring in the way they are trying to improve these kids' lives but like everything else in our current economic situation....without funding, what one can do becomes quite limited.

I will face one of my ultimate fears and BUNGEE JUMP at BRIGHTON MARINA on the 3rd of SEPTEMBER (time TBA for any supporters!). Please help with ANYTHING you can, even £1 is £1 more for these kids. 100% of the proceeds will go directly to Chesswood, to be used specifically for the purposes above. I know I'm aiming high and of course I understand our current economic situation, but without dreaming a dream life makes little sense. I will be incredibly grateful for anything you can give, and your effort will be much appreciated.

Young Carers



Does your child or a child you know help to look after a relative with a disability, special needs, illness, mental health condition, or drug or alcohol problem?

Young carers may undertake all sorts of help, support and care activities beyond normal expectations of a child in the same age group i.e. beyond keeping the bed room tidy and helping with some household chores.

Examples of help, support and care activities

- Practical tasks, like cooking, housework and shopping.
- Physical care, such as helping someone out of bed.
- Emotional support, including talking to someone who is distressed.
- Personal care, such as helping someone dress.
- Managing the family budget and collecting prescriptions.
- Helping to give medicine.
- Helping someone communicate.
- Looking after brothers and sisters.

School Library books

During the summer holidays, please can you check to see if you have any school library books and return these to the school in September.

Kids eat free over the summer



Tesco is offering free kids' meals to Clubcard holders with any item purchased in 311 of its cafés. Free meals include the kids breakfast, kids hot meal deal and kids cold pick and mix deal. Parents can spend as little as 60p on a piece of fresh fruit for the kids to eat for free.



Asda launched its Kids Eat for £1 offer at its cafés across the country. Children aged 16 and under can eat for just £1 at any supermarket café, seven days a week, with no minimum adult spend required.



During the school holidays, children aged 16 and under can get one free meal with every adult meal at Morrisons cafés. The adult meal must be at least £4.49.



Sainsbury's Cafes offer one child hot meal or lunch bag for £1 with any adult main meal purchased over £5.20. This offer is on every day from 11.30am. Kid's mains include one main, 3 sides a drink and a piece of fruit.



M&S will be running its Kids Eat Free offer at M&S cafés. For every £5 that customers spend in the café, they'll be entitled to a free 'kids' munch menu'. This includes a hot breakfast main and drink before 11am, and a hot or cold lunch main, snack and drink after 11am.



Dunelm - in the Dunelm Café Pausa Kids eat free every day. With each paying adult spending £4 or more, get a kids' meal deal free. Choose 1 main, 2 snacks and 1 drink.

Thursday 20th & Friday 21st July

Please note that on the last two days of the summer term pupils will be able to wear their own clothes to school in return for donations of clean and outgrown branded uniform, along with PE kits, trousers and skirts. Please note that we do not need any shirts/blouses at this time. We thank you for your support with this.

Water at school

We are just reminding parents that children should only be drinking water whilst in school.

We are seeking to support children's health and well-being and need parents help to do this.

We would ask that drinking bottles are sent in that are appropriate and wherever possible not branded.

Please also ensure that your child's name is on their bottle so that it can be re-united with them if it was to go missing.

Medication

For parents of children who have medication in school, this will be sent home with your child at the end of term.

Please remember to bring in any medication that is required to be administered in school on their first day back in September with the completed parental consent form which can be found below.

PUPIL PREMIUM

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

Could you and your child be ENTITLED to help with costs towards clubs/trips/receive food vouchers/free holiday activity clubs during school holidays and free school meals?

If you meet any of the following criteria, then you could be entitled:

- **Income Support**
- **Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance**
- **Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)**
- **Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit**
- **Universal Credit – if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)**



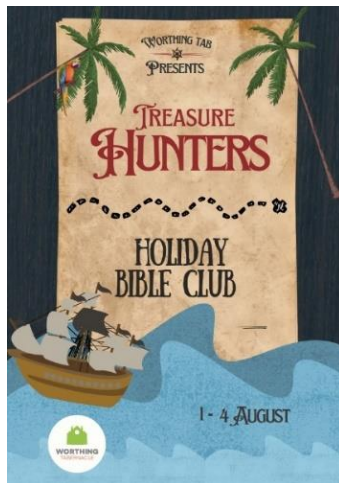
