Is your child entitled?

With the constant rise of the cost of living, is your household income less than £16190.

If so, your child may be entitled to Pupil Premium/Free School meals.

Earrings and jewellery in school

We have noticed that children are wearing jewellery in school.

Children may wear a watch for school – analogue or digital. Other jewellery is not typically permitted in school unless there are exceptional religious reasons supported by an authorised religious leader.
