With the constant rise of the cost of living, is your household income less than £16190.

We have noticed that children are wearing jewellery in school.









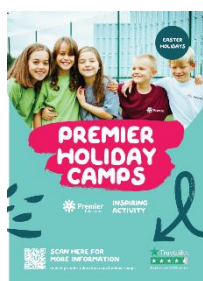
