Year 4 – Weald & Downland Museum trip - October 2019

As part of our History topic of 'Were the Dark Ages Dark?', we intend to take Y4 pupils to the Weald and Downland Museum in order to study how people lived in Anglo-Saxon times. During the visit children will attend two workshops:

- 'Food through the Ages' which will include Anglo-Saxon food preparation, cooking bread and having a taster session.
- 'Health and medicine through the Ages' which will include exploring Anglo Saxon remedies and finding out about healing properties of plants

If you would like your child to go to the Weald and Downland Museum, please would you complete the slip below and return it to school by **Friday 4th October 2019** ensuring that you detail any food allergies that your child may have.

The children will need to wear old clothes for the visit and, depending on the weather, they may require waterproof clothing. The children will need to wear comfortable shoes or trainers for walking on uneven ground. They will need to bring **a packed lunch and a drink in a carton or bottle**; no glass please for the trip. No spending money will be needed for this visit.

The dates of the visits are as follows:-

- **Thursday 17th October – 4JH & 4OM**
- **Thursday 24th October – 4PB & 4SU**

The cost of the visit to the Weald & Downland Museum is **£17.00**. Payment may be made online via SchoolsBuddy or by cash or cheque. If paying by cash or cheque please complete and return the attached slip with your payment to the school office. If paying online you do not need to return the form. Please ensure all payments reach us by **Friday 4th October 2019**. Regrettably, we are no longer able to subsidise these visits for all pupil premium children (currently entitled to free school meals or have been entitled within the past six years or adopted from within the United Kingdom). All parents will therefore need to make a full voluntary contribution to ensure that the visit can proceed. We also need parent helpers on the visit so please indicate on the reply slip if you are able to do so or see your child's class teacher as soon as possible as a DBS check may be required.
