### Year 3 Visit to Wakehurst Place







To enrich the pupils' learning experience of our science topic on Plants, we have arranged a visit to Wakehurst Place, near Haywards Heath.

Whilst the children are at Wakehurst Place they will be involved in two workshops to include:

- Flower structure & plant reproduction
- Millennium Seed Bank and Trail

They will also have the time explore the gardens in small groups.

The children will need to wear school uniform for the visit and, depending on the weather, they may require waterproof clothing. The children will need to wear comfortable shoes or trainers. They will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink in a carton or bottle; no glass please for the trip. No spending money will be needed for this visit.

The dates of the visits are as follows:-

- Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 3LB, 3ML & 3MH
- Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020 3AG & 3DH

In order to make the most of our visit to Wakehurst Place we will be setting off early and coming back late. Please could children arrive at school at **8.30am**. We will be home at **approximately 3.30pm**.

The cost of the trip is £19.00. This needs to be paid online or by cheque by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2020. Regrettably, we are no longer able to subsidise these visits for all pupil premium children (currently entitled to free school meals or have been entitled within the past six years or adopted from within the United Kingdom). All parents will therefore need to make a full voluntary contribution to ensure that the visit can proceed. If paying by cheque or cash, please complete the attached slip and return it with your payment to the school office. If paying online you will need to tick the consent box before making your payment. Please ensure all payments reach us by **Friday 28**<sup>th</sup> **February 2020**.
