Year 6 Michelham Priory Trip – March 2020

Dear Parents

To enrich the pupils' learning experience of the 'Home Front', we have planned a visit to Michelham Priory, near Hailsham, as part of our World War Two topic.

Whilst the children are at Michelham Priory they will be involved in workshops, to include:

- Interviews with real WW2 'veterans'
- Investigating artefacts and life in wartime Michelham
- 'Make Do and Mend'
- Writing home as an evacuee with dip pens and Indian ink

Tuesday 17th March – 6BP, 6RW & 6SJ
Wednesday 18th March – 6TH, 6OP & 6EP

We will be travelling by coach, leaving Chesswood at 9.00 am and returning by approximately 3.30 pm.

Pupils will need to dress as an Evacuee (please see pictures below for ideas), wear sensible shoes, bring a packed lunch along with drinks for both lunch time and the rest of the day. If your child wishes to bring pocket money for the shop, we recommend £3.00 maximum. However, this is optional.

The cost of this trip will be **£19.50** per pupil and needs to be paid via SchoolsBuddy or cheque by **Friday 6th March 2020**. Regrettably, we are no longer able to subsidise these visits for all pupil premium children (currently entitled to free school meals or have been entitled within the past six years or adopted from within the United Kingdom). All parents will therefore need to make a full voluntary contribution to ensure that the visit can proceed. If you are not able to provide the donation of the full amount please contact our Finance Administrator, Kate Brown, on kbrown@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk.

We will, of course, take all reasonable care of the children, but neither we, nor the Local Authority, can be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury unless caused directly by staff or helpers in charge of the party.

We have been advised by West Sussex County Council, to ensure that all parents know that if their child feels unwell some days or weeks after outdoor activities, particularly where flu-like symptoms are involved, they should consult their doctor and tell them where they have visited.
