Changing Arrangements - "absolutely necessary"

Dear Parent,

My team are working tirelessly at the present time and your very positive comments are keeping them highly motivated to continue – keep them coming © We have set out some further guidance in response to changes and developments at national level and with managing our provision locally. Thank you for working in partnership with us and making sensible decisions throughout this time, it really has allowed things to work well for all.

### **Limited Community Opening**

Following changed Government guidance last night, the following policy on school attendance is now required:

School attendance must only be when absolutely necessary.

Key Workers: A child may attend school when:

- A designated key worker is required in work, at any time, during the same school day (8:50 to 15:15) or
  has finished a night shift the preceding night. It is helpful if children attend all day (8:50 3:15) regardless
  of shift length or timing.
   and
- No other responsible adult, whom they live with, is at home (whether they are home-working or not).
  - o In the case of families that are separated and a child regularly (at least weekly) spends time with another parent and they are home when the key worker is undertaking a shift, we would ask that the child uses that base rather than attend the school environment (whether they are homeworking or not), unless it is absolutely necessary. We would hope families will be flexible in this regard to minimise school attendance.

It is important that families do not worry about our capacity or feel guilty in any way if their child needs to attend school. We have capacity and are ready to welcome every single child where it is absolutely necessary. #### Free School Meals

Children attending limited community service currently – all children are able to secure a lunch, free of charge, each day until the end of this week. Please let the school office know office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk

After this week, if a child needs a school meal parents should order and pay using the normal Chartwells online ordering system.

Free School Meals – any child eligible for free school meals, whether they are normally claimed or not, is eligible for a hamper. The delivery of these hampers to school will start tomorrow. If you would like a hamper to collect from school premises and you are well enough to collect please confirm by email: <a href="mailto:office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk">office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk</a>; or contact the school by phone 01903 204141. We will contact every family eligible for free school meals if we don't hear from you by Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 8:00 a.m. The food hampers will be sufficient for 5 days.

### Easter opening

We are making arrangements for Easter opening for children. This will be for key workers or where



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there are exceptional needs and respite care is required by a family e.g. Education, Health Care Plan or a child protection plan. This facility will only be open to children where it is absolutely necessary.

If you believe the above applies to your current circumstances then please complete the online form by Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 5p.m., in the first instance, so that we can arrange appropriate staffing. If there is some difficulty completing the online form i.e. you are not yet aware of your shift pattern please complete 'free text box' to explain – we will accept your best guess and understand this may very well change – everything else is at the moment! Either way, there are more important things to be concerned about so we will be open and if the above criteria applies your child will have a place, this will include short notice changes.

### Learning and teaching arrangements

We are now planning learning in 3 separate tiers:

- **Limited community opening** today we have 48 and yesterday we had 66. We will be planning the Easter opening arrangements in the coming days for key workers and when it is absolutely necessary.
- Online distance learning this seems to have taken on a whole life of its own and Charlie Brown (the dog!) seems to be an internet sensation!
- Home Learning Packs we are currently developing home learning packs for two specific reasons and they will be used only when absolutely necessary:
  - 1. for children and families that have no internet access or no appropriate equipment to learn online i.e. only a smart phone. Should this apply to you please contact us on 01903 204141
  - 2. for children on the special needs register that need a bespoke learning programme. Should this apply, a member of the special educational needs team will be in contact before the end of the week to make arrangements.

We will make arrangements directly with a family to collect these home learning pack from the school premises when it is absolutely necessary. Given the current restrictions we would provide 3-5 days work in each pack. Outcomes from the tasks will not be marked by school staff – we will provide marking guidance where appropriate for home marking.
