



*Chac*

The rainmaker god, Chac was often shown covered in scales and with fangs and a hooked snout. He carried a serpent as a symbol of lightning.



*Ah Bolon Tzacab*

This leaf-nosed god of farming was associated with royal power and the offering of human blood. Kings often held a sceptre (a ceremonial staff) in the shape of this god.



*Ah K'in*

Also known as Kinich Ahau, Ah K'in was the god of the Sun and controlled drought and disease. He was often shown as a man with a hooked nose.



*Buluc Chabtan*

This was the god of war, violence, and sudden death (including human sacrifices). He was usually shown with a black line down one cheek.
