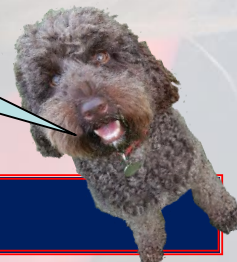

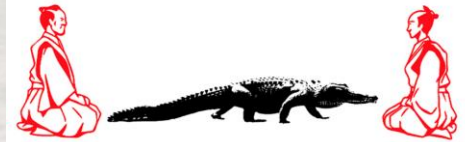

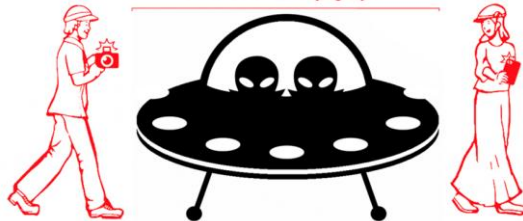

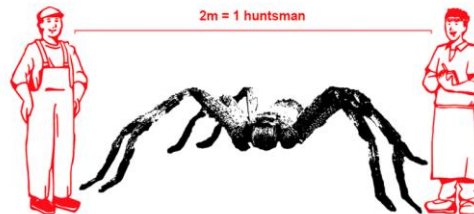

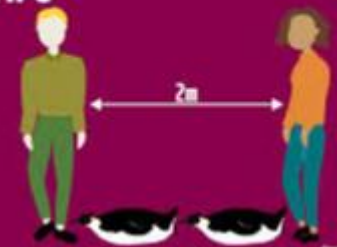

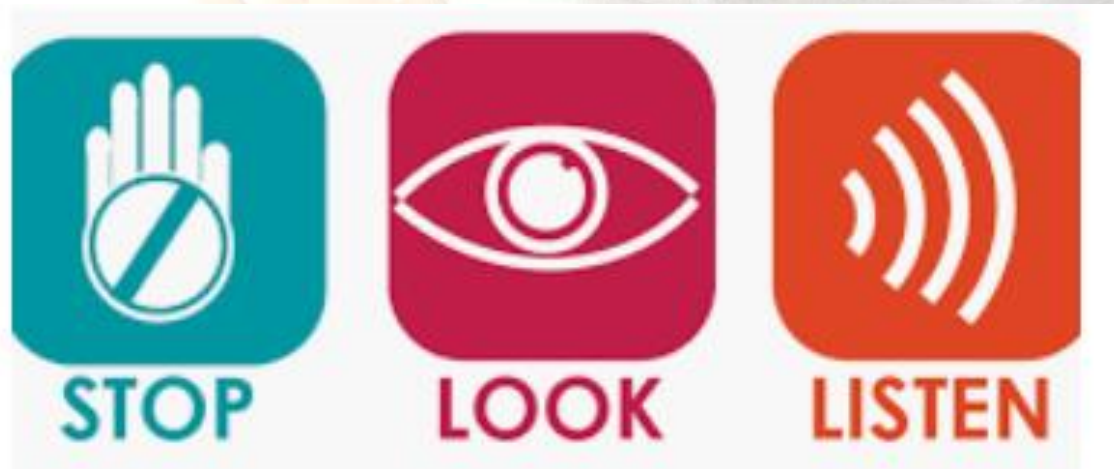

- As you may be using different gates to normal (this will be explained later), the next slide shows you where to cross roads safely.

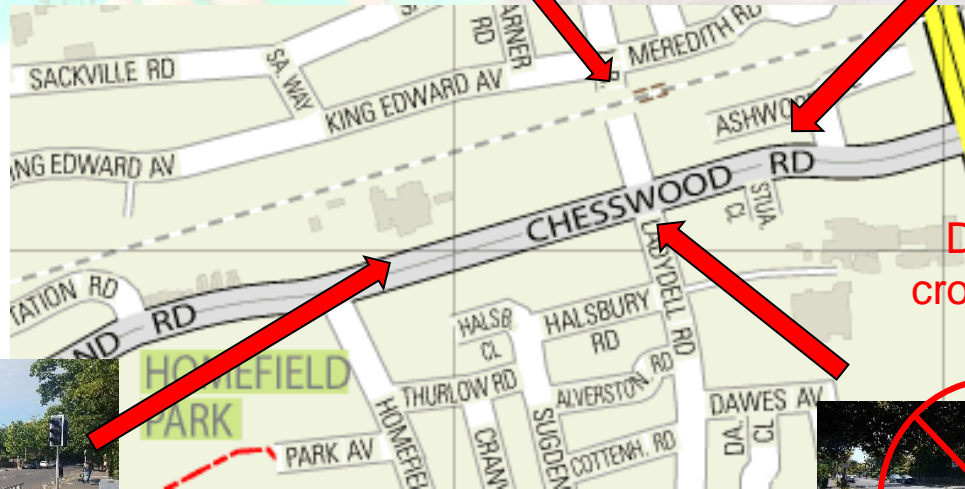


Road Safety – Where to Cross Roads

What do I wear?

- You do not have to wear uniform
- You should wear clean clothes each day
- You must wear clothes that you can do exercise in (you do not need to bring a PE kit as we will not change for PE)
- You must wear trainers



What do I need to bring?

- You will need a pencil case (kept on your desk)
 - Essential
 - Handwriting pen
 - Pencil
 - Ruler
 - Reading book
 - Desirable
 - Glue stick
 - Colouring pencils
 - Safety scissors

What class will I be in?

- Over the last few weeks, we have had a number of **key children** in school from across all year groups. Some of you may have just been in for some days and not others. These children will still be coming to school on the days they have booked.
- From Wednesday 3rd of June we will be welcoming back all **Year 6 children** (full-time) who have accepted a space.
- **If you have been a key child in school AND are in Year 6 – you will be in full-time with the rest of Year 6**
- When you arrive on Wednesday 3rd of June, you will be told which group you will be in. Your teachers are building the groups and will place you with friends.

What class will I be in?

Classes will be much smaller than you are used to. We are calling these 'bubbles'.

- **Key Children Bubbles**
 - If you are in Y3,4,5 and are coming to school, these will be the classes
 - 3a, 3b, 3c
 - 4a, 4b, 4c, 4d
 - 5a, 5b
- **Year 6 Bubbles**
 - If you are in Year 6 and are coming to school, these will be the classes
 - TH1 & TH2
 - EP1 & EP2
 - RW1 & RW2
 - OP1 & OP2
 - SJ1 & SJ2
 - BP1 & BP2



For the Year 6 'Bubbles', children will be split across 2 groups with a maximum of 12 in each. Your teachers will decide the bubbles based on the friendships in class

What do I do when I arrive?

- **Key Children (Y3,4,5)** children must use the front gate
 - You must arrive between **08:30 and 08:45**
- **Year 6** must use Ladydell Road entrance (end of the field)
 - 6TH / 6RW / 6EP must arrive between **08:30 and 08:40 (ready to start school at 08:45)**
 - 6SJ / 6OP / 6BP must arrive between **08:45 and 08:55 (ready to start school at 09:00)**
- If you have **brothers or sisters** attending school at a different time, don't worry, you can come together at the earlier time
- On Wednesday 3rd of June, there will be plenty of staff to help and direct you to your group (bubble) zone

What do I do when I arrive?

You may need your parents to help you understand this – and there will be adults to help when you arrive.
GO STRAIGHT TO YOUR ZONE - stay 2m apart (these will be clearly marked for you)

For siblings who have different arrival times, please arrive at the earlier time together – you can sit on the benches on the front playground



Entering the classroom

- When it is time to go in to school, **your teacher will collect you from your designated zone**
- You will be walked to your classroom – using the external doors wherever possible (all classrooms apart from those upstairs)
- Your teacher will allow you in, one at a time – you will **wash your hands** then **go to your seat**, placing your **bag carefully under your desk**. We are not using lockers.

What will my classroom be like?

- Your classroom will look different
 - Desks will be 2m apart (social distancing)
 - You will have your own desk to yourself
 - There will only be 12 desks in the classroom
 - You will have a folder of work on your desk – the teacher will be working through this with you across the week
 - You will need to keep your resources on your desk and **not share them with anyone** – pen / pencil / ruler etc
 - There will be a teacher zone marked on the floor – you mustn't enter this
 - Your classroom will be linked to another classroom, with the rest of your classmates in – you will be able to see and hear them via the interactive whiteboard in your class





What will my timetable be like?

- We will try to have as many lessons outside as possible
- You will have most of the usual lessons that you are used to in school
- Any PE and music will be taken by your class teachers
- You will have PE every day
- For Year 6 children (except key children), your week will finish on Friday at 12.15 / 12.30

What will lessons be like?

- Lessons won't be hugely different. To start with, we will be completing work similar to that which has been set for the home-learning. We hope to get back to as close to your full curriculum soon – e.g. we'll try and find a way to do something with the Goblin Car Project in Year 6
- The main difference will be maintaining social distancing from each other – teachers and friends. For that reason there will be very little moving around the classroom – we can still chat and discuss ideas though.

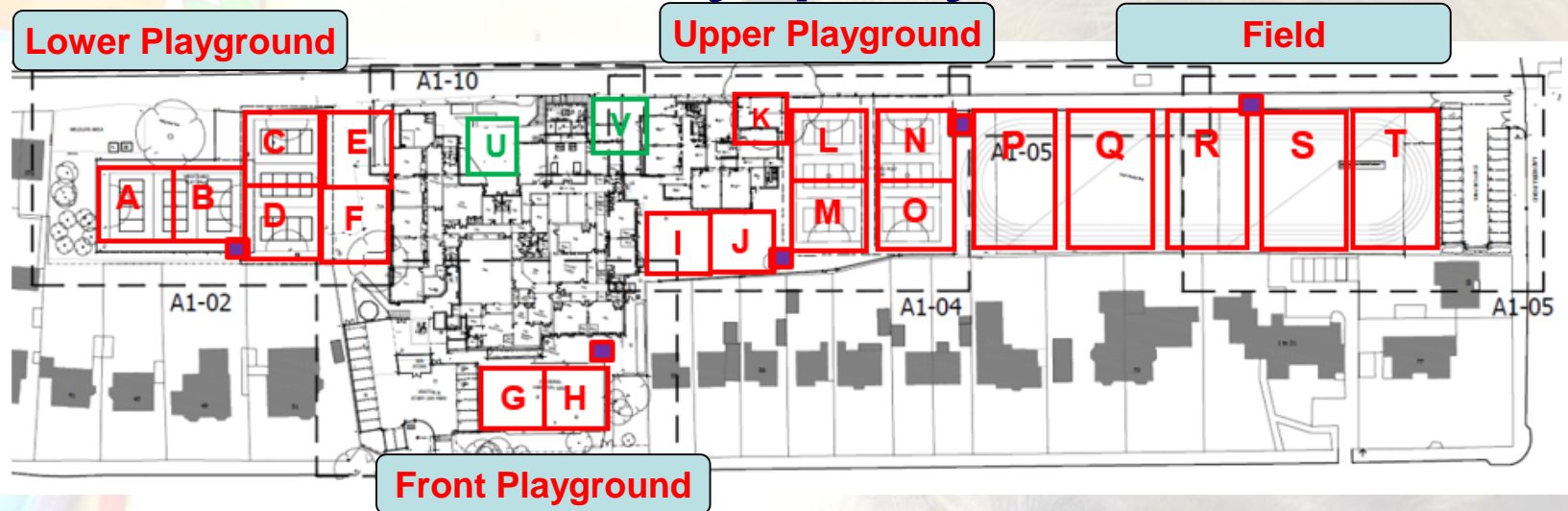
What will playtimes be like?

- Breaks will be staggered – only half of the school will be outside at any one time.
- Your teacher will take you to your special zoned area for playtime (and collect you after)
- Your zone is for your 'bubble only'
- Unfortunately, you can only play with other children in your bubble – we can still have lots of fun though



- We will teach you games that you can play and still keep 2m apart

What do I do for lunch?

- Lunch will be in classrooms – packed lunches and hot meals
- Hot lunches will be served to your classrooms
- Lunch supervisors will serve to your classroom door – you will collect it
- Once you have finished, you will be asked to bring your plate to the classroom door

Going to the toilet

- Toilets will be a '1 in, 1 out' system – you are not allowed in there with anyone else, including friends
- There will be clear signs and marked areas to show where to wait
- At breaks, these will be monitored
- During lesson times, you will need to check first by calling 'is anyone in there?'
- Queue using the 2m marks to maintain social distancing



Moving around school

- There will be minimal movement around school as you will use external doors to the playgrounds
- We will not be using shared areas – eg hall / music room etc
- Follow the one way system – where it exists
- Use the lines to keep 2m apart
- All doors will be kept open with door stops to minimise surfaces we have to touch
- Do not go past any 'no entry' signs



Moving around school - Stairs

- There should only be one group of children using the stairs at one time (only Year 6)
- When the first child gets to the stairs, check to see if another class is coming in the other direction
 - if they are, then give way to them
 - If the stairs are empty, then proceed





End of the day

- **Key Children (Y3,4,5)** must use the front gate
 - You will leave school at **15:00 (3pm)**
- **Year 6** must use Ladydell Road entrance (end of the field)
 - 6TH / 6RW / 6EP will leave school at
 - **Mon – Thurs 15:00 (3 pm) / Fri 12:15 (except key children)**
 - 6SJ / 6OP / 6BP will leave school at
 - **Mon – Thurs 15:15 (3.15 pm) / Fri 12:30 (except key children)**
 - If you have **brothers or sisters** attending school at a different time, don't worry, you can leave at the later time
- Your teacher will lead you to the relevant gate

Other Changes

- There will be no clubs
- Breakfast club and after-school club will be for keyworker children only
- There won't be any assemblies – although we may get one beamed live into your classrooms
- The weather is likely to be warm and as you aren't wearing uniform – **SHIRTS DON'T NEED TO BE TUCKED IN 😊**
- We're aware there may be some lockdown hairstyles going on – embrace it
