Picking up after school and extra-curricular clubs: We would like to ask all parents to ensure their children know, understand and will do the following (all club leaders will also be asked to reconfirm this procedure with the children in their club):

In the event of uncertainty at the end of the school day or after school club when a parent is not waiting in their usual spot a child:

- Must wait within the school grounds at the usual spot for a short period of time (approximately 5 minutes).
- Must report to the reception desk at the main entrance. A call will then be made to the parent to resolve the situation
- Must Not, under any circumstances leave the school premises to look for their parent.

We would also ask parents to ONLY pick children up from the front playground after an extra-curricular club, this makes it significantly easier for a school to resolve any pick up difficulties; reduces stress and anxiety for children; increase children's safety particularly during the dark winter period.

Department of Education Census

The survey is part of Census required by the Department of Education and therefore <u>it is vital that all</u> <u>families complete it.</u> This is a statutory requirement under Section 537A of the Education Act 1996 to provide them with data – this is done on a termly basis.

Rail Strikes: The RMT union has announced that it plans industrial action on the following dates:

- Tuesday 11 October until Thursday 13 October
- Tuesday 18 October until Thursday 20 October
- Thursday 3 November until Saturday 5 November
- Tuesday 22 November until Wednesday 23 November
- Tuesday 6 December until Thursday 8 December

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If these strikes go ahead they will have a significant effect on services, and Southern Rail regret the potentially considerable disruption and inconvenience to students, families and staff who rely on their services. Snow Dogs by the Sea: The Martlets Hospice has teamed up with Wild in Art and Penguin to stage an extraordinary public art trail in Brighton & Hove. The magical sculpture trail features 45 giant Snowdog sculptures, inspired by the much loved animated short film, The Snowman™ and The Snowdog.

Our Snowdogs, beautifully decorated by artists and generously sponsored by <u>local</u> <u>businesses</u>, will be on show from Saturday 24th September to 27th November across Brighton & Hove. There will even be a Snowdog at London's Victoria Station!

They are joined by a pack of 20 Snowdog puppy sculptures designed by local school children, which are on show for the duration of the trail, at Brighton Museum & Art Gallery, Booth Museum of Natural History, Hove Library, Hove Museum and Jubilee Library.

At the end of the trail sculptures will be auctioned to raise funds for Martlets Hospice.
