Into Y4 were we had Olanna runner up in the 400m, Macy and Cameron runners up in the 50m, Oscar 4th in the 400, Cameron 3rd in the long jump and Jonathan 3rd in the Howler throw – when all results were collated our Y4 team won their age group in athletics!!!

Y5 Alisa 'The Bullet' won her 75m sprint and also anchored the relay team (Isla, Lily T and Kate) to victory. Reuben also won the howler throw with another massive throw.

Y6 Natalie was 3rd in the 600m and 5th in the howler throw, Michael was 4th in the long jump and the boys relay team 3rd (Michael, Luis, Elliot and Ezekiel).
