## 6. External events – All – Information

### WORTHING FOODBANK

Worthing Foodbank helps people in short term crisis, with emergency food, while care agencies help in the long term.

JUBILEE CHURCH runs the project but we distribute our food from:-

WORTHING TABERNACLE in Central Worthing

People can find themselves without food for a number of reasons, including sickness, redundancy or benefit delays.

Front line care professionals assess people who are in need and give out special Foodbank vouchers. These vouchers can be exchanged for 3 days food supply at the centre.

Foodbank collects the food from local shoppers at various supermarkets once a month. Shoppers are given a "shopping list" and asked to buy and donate an item from the list.
