1. School Entry – Pupil Safety – All – Action

Polite Reminder: Children must not enter school premises before 8:30 a.m. unless they are part of a school organised activity. Please see detail below for more information

In recent months we have introduced some 'Early Bird' support lessons for children in school. We also have a long-standing school breakfast club. This means there are many children entering school before 8:30 a.m. each day. However, all of the children in Breakfast club and 'Early Birds' are registered and supervised, so they are safe. In recent weeks we have noticed an increasing number of children being dropped off from 8 a.m. that are not part of any organised activity. This is understandable as the gate is open to allow other children in for the organised activities but we need to request that children and parents remain outside of the school gate until 8:30 a.m., if not part of an organised activity.

Unfortunately, we are unable to allow this as we have no supervision available for them therefore they are potentially unsafe. If parents need to drop children off before 8:30a.m. for any reason, we need to ask that they sign their child into breakfast club – the charge for this service is £3. The breakfast club meets in the 'new hall' to the rear of the school. Alternatively, parents need to wait with children at the front gate until the playground clock reads 8:30a.m. or there is a member of school staff on the front gate.
