1. Free School Meals - All - Action

Free School Meal Registration – We need your help NOW!

We would like to appeal to families who meet the following criteria to register for free school meals. By registering your child they do not need to have a free school meal but it does mean they will be entitled to an extra £1300 each year for at least six years to help support their learning and access to school activities:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

The funding is used in a variety of ways with school to benefit registered children, such as:

 Additional support in school – teaching assistant support in the classroom; counselling services within school; pastoral support available every day

- High need, high support class the funding also enables us to maintain a very small support class
 in Y6 which also reduces class sizes in all other classes within the year group. This very valuable
 arrangement could be extended if all eligible parents registered for FSM.
- Tutorial support there are up to two one hour sessions available for children registered for FSM to enjoy and benefit from small group teaching sessions with their own class teacher.
- Extra music support i.e.: Rocksteady
- Free breakfast club access with IXL club
- School visits: financial support available to ensure children can access day and residential visits

Your child does not have to have a free meal daily but if they would like to, the school will ensure one is available (with prior notice).

2. Meet the teacher Session – All – Action

As the new Year is now well underway, we are offering you an opportunity to meet your child's new class teacher. The short session (45 mins) will enable your child's new teacher to introduce themselves; share important information about this year's curriculum, homework and other 'housekeeping' information e.g. important dates, trips, weekly timetable, how to get in contact with the class teacher etc. Year 6 teachers will also focus on the Y6 National Test arrangements and appropriate (low stress!) preparation for them. Parents will also have the opportunity to ask general questions about the year to ensure you are in a good position to support your child.


We now have a permanent book shop located outside of Mr Jolley's office, parents can browse the discount books with their children before and after school and then take them to Reception to purchase.
