We received a formal complaint in writing yesterday from the NHS skin clinic with regard to parking on their site. To make matters worse, the driver, a parent of a child at Chesswood, is reported to have been difficult about signage not being clear regarding parking restrictions. Whilst the clinic will now use scarce NHS resources to improve signage – we would look to ALL parents to park and behave in a reasonable and responsible way in line with parking restrictions and neighbours of the school so public money does not need to be spent to display the obvious. Equally, it is a complete waste of staff time processing the complaints when we could be focussed on the achievement of children at school. We have recommended that the driver is reported to Operation Crackdown as the registration number was taken. Having checked on the DVLA website the vehicle is also not taxed. As a school we will support any and all action to enforce safer and considerate parking.
