### Barnardo's Dice Programme for Parents

Dice is a supportive, non-judgemental 4 week programme for parents and carers who are concerned that their child (approx. age 9-14) might be 'at risk' and therefore, possibly vulnerable to exploitation. The programme will focus on strategies and information to help support parents/carers in keeping their child safer from harm, as they approach and go through adolescence.

The programme is delivered over two hour in workshop sessions by two trained Barnardo's project leaders. Each session will be relaxed and informal, with a variety of activities, discussions and videos. There will be a maximum of 12 parents/carers, providing an ideal opportunity to meet others in similar situations and to share and learn in a caring, non-judgmental, confidential and safe setting. The programme includes refreshments, plus tea/coffee breaks.
