5. Multiplication Tables Check – All – Information

Between June 10th and June 28th, Year 4 children will participate in the national pilot of a new times tables assessment. This will involve the children answering 25 times table questions, each with a 6-second time limit. This assessment is being introduced to monitor whether Year 4 children across the country are able to fluently recall times table facts for all tables up to 12x12, a requirement of the National Curriculum. Children are very familiar with this style of questioning due to TT Rock Stars. When working on Maths at home during this period, please prioritise times table recall. This could be using TT Rock Stars, IXL – see this week's Year 4 homework for suggested activities, or using Chesswood Cards. Additional cards are available from Mr Gilbert if needed. 6. Summer Fayre – All – Information

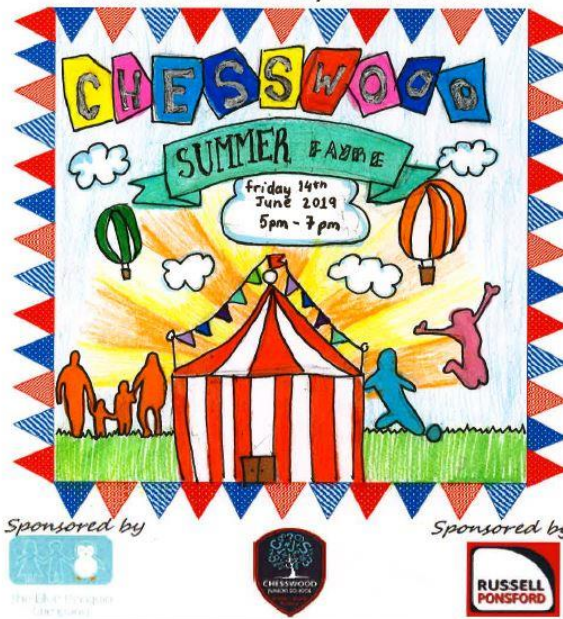

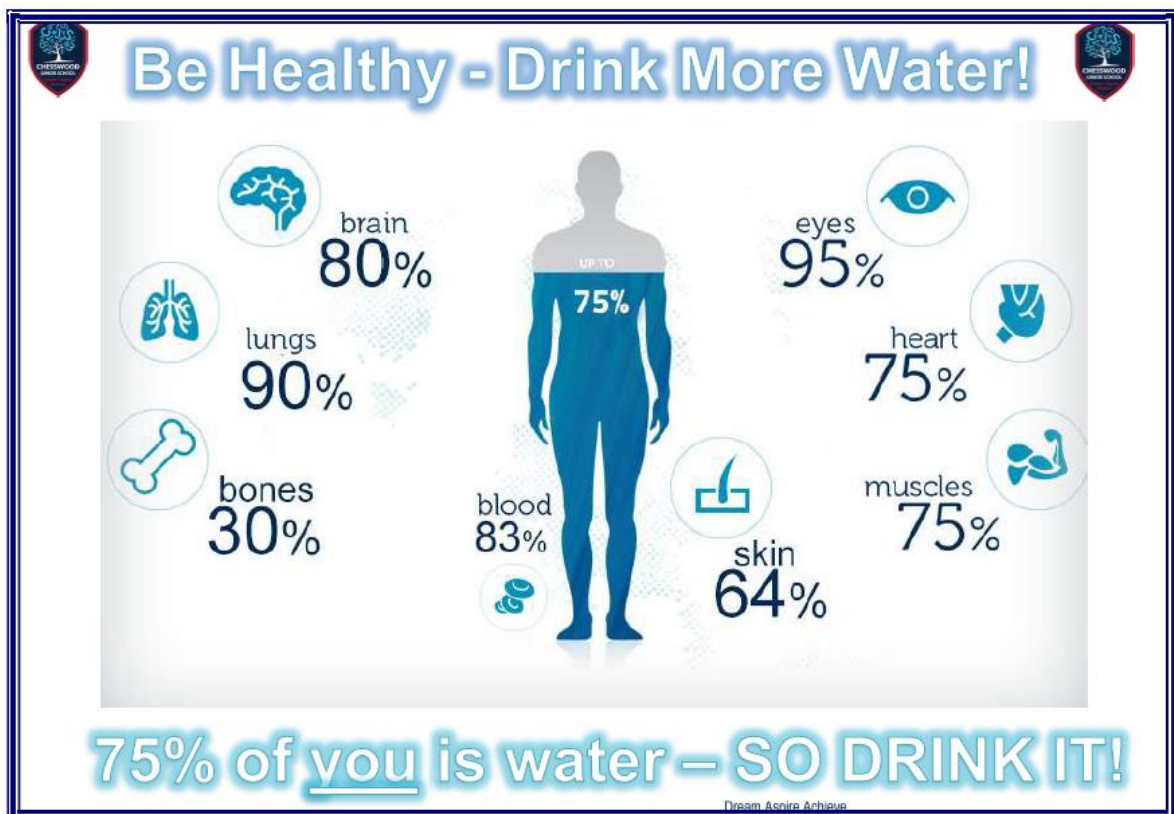
