Although I like tennis, I prefer golf.

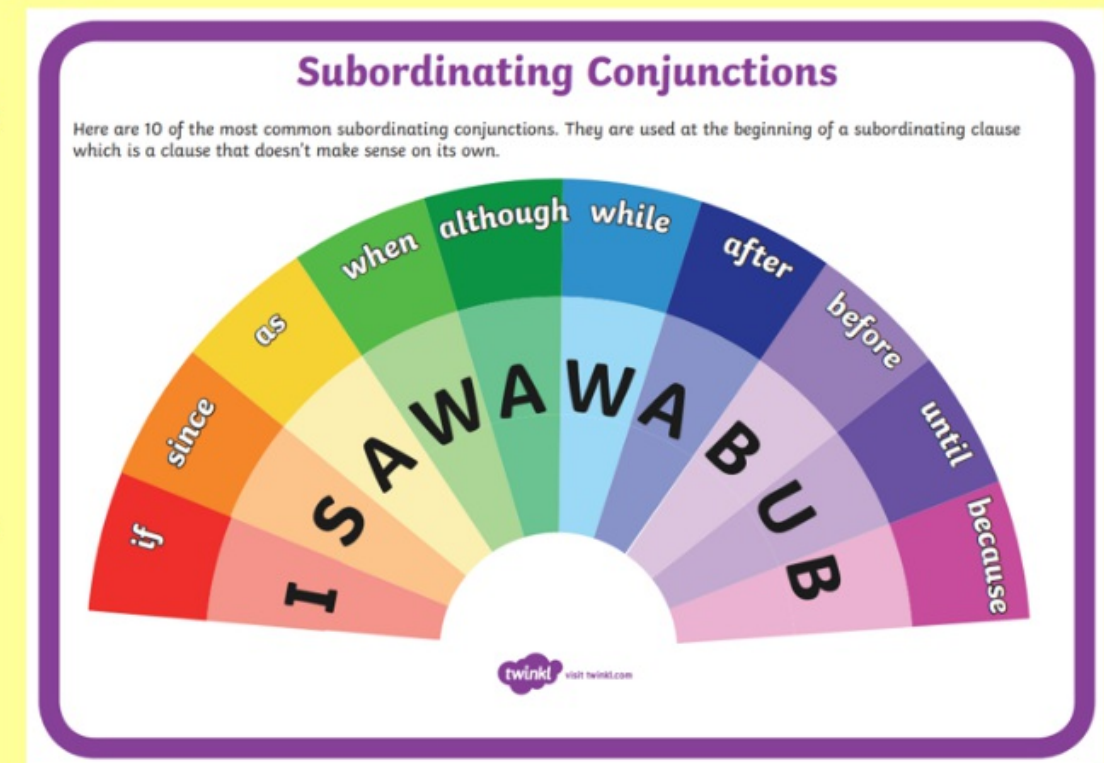
