Our Solar System

What do they eat?

What a shark eats depends on its species and where it lives. Most sharks are carnivores because they like to eat fish and other sharks. Some larger sharks eat dolphins, sea lions and small whales. Smaller sharks eat smaller prey such as clams, crabs and squid.

Some types of shark can be deadly, but only about 12 species have ever attacked humans. In fact, shark attacks are not very common. More people die from bee stings and natural disasters such as earthquakes and volcanoes each year than from shark attacks.

The island of Ireland is shared by the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland (part of the United Kingdom). It's known as the Emerald Isle for its lush green pastures. You'll find lakes, called loughs, and mountains dotted with ancient carved stones and prehistoric monuments. There are farms, villages, and Ireland's lively capital city, Dublin. The River Shannon is the longest in the British Isles, at 240 miles (386 km) long.

HOLA (oll ah)

This is Spain, famous for brave bull-fighting toreadors, castanet-clacking flamenco dancers, a moustache-twirling surrealist artist and possibly the 'most spectacular building in the world'. It's only 15km (9 miles) across the sea to Africa (grab your rubber ring) and the North African Moors ruled this land for nearly 1000 years, leaving spectacular castles behind. If you don't want to fight the bulls, run with them. (And, if you don't want to eat the tomatoes, throw them at your friends.)

What foods are harvested?

During autumn, many foods are harvested. Foods such as pumpkins, carrots, cauliflower, sweetcorn and apples are harvested in the autumn.
