Writing	This week in our writing we are focusing on editing, proof-reading and then publishing our Greek Myths. Use the flip to help you with this but the most important thing that you have to do is to read everything you have written out loud and to ask yourself the following questions: 1) Does each sentence make sense and if not why not e.g. have I missed any words out or repeated myself? 2) Have I stayed in the past tense throughout? 3) Does my story make sense or do I need to add something in or take something out so that it does? 4) Does my opening describe the setting and introduce and describe some or all of the main characters? 5) Have you used different senses to describe the villain or monster? 6) Is your problem clear and have you resolved it? 7) Have you written an ending that tells us either how the main characters have changed or what they have learnt? When you have done all this please use the success criteria on the flip to make sure that you have included all of the features that we have asked you to and then write up your myths in neat. The last lesson asks you to pick out some of the key features that you have used, e.g. fronted adverbials or relative clauses, and to then explain to us how they make your writing better.
