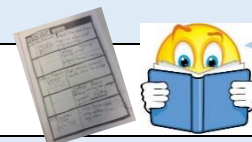
Our Current Learning

Spellings are learnt fortnightly across 2 weeks running from Wednesday to Tuesday.

We are currently in Week 2.

Spelling Week 2 commences Wednesday 25/11/20 and concludes Tuesday 01/12/20. Week 2 includes a mid-point assessment at the start of the week to identify which spellings the children have learnt during week 1 and a further spelling test at the end of the week to identify which spellings they learnt during the 2 weeks.

Next week (Week 12), a new set of spellings will be issued with Week 1 commencing Wednesday 02/12/20 and concluding Tuesday 08/12/20. Week 1 includes an initial test at the start of the week to identify which words the children already know.

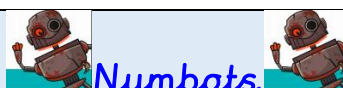
