What is a subordinating conjunction?

A subordinating clause can go at the end and at the beginning of a sentence.

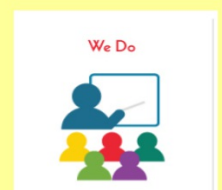

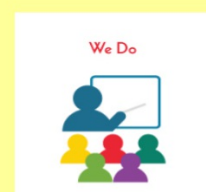
