Suffixes

When we add a suffix to the end of a word, it changes what part of speech it is:

Eg happy (*adjective*) happi<u>ness</u> (noun)

Sometimes, we need to change the spelling of the original word (eg the 'y' in happy changes to an 'i').

Some suffixes also affect a word's meaning:

Eg care**ful** (taking care) care**less** (not taking care!)

These are four suffixes that you need to know in Year 6:

- -ance -ancy
- -ence -ency

All of these suffixes are used with nouns.
