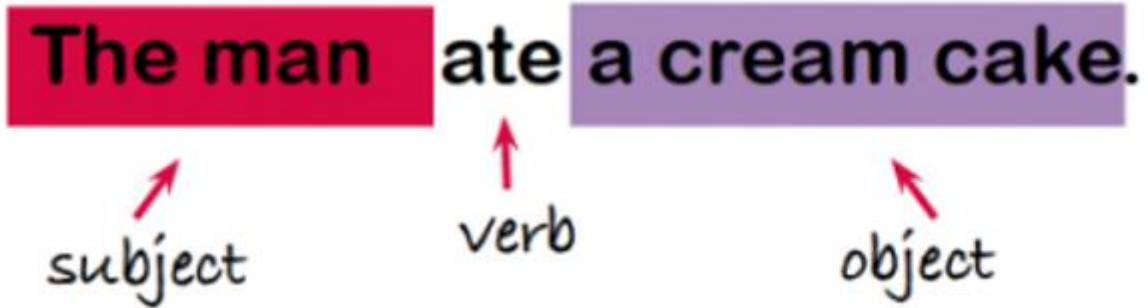


Subject and Object
