## Abstract and Concrete Nouns



Concrete Noun = A place, person or thing that can be seen, heard, tasted, touched or smelt.

Abstract Noun = The opposite of the above. Something that cannot be seen, heard, tasted, touched or smelt. E.g.- An event (wedding), a feeling (joy, anger) or an idea/concept (truth, permission)
